Applications should be returned as soon as possible before April 30th.

The St. Luke Endowment Award is available to students who will be enrolled full time in a synodically affiliated college, university, or seminary in the fall of the year of application. All applicants must have an established relationship with St. Luke Lutheran Church and plan to be in full time professional services for the Lutheran Church – Missouri Synod upon completion of their studies. Payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the college, university, or seminary, and credited to the recipients school account. The recipient is responsible for notifying the scholarship chairman of any college, university, or seminary address change.

All interested applicants must complete an application packet consisting of the following forms:

- Application Form** - all of your responses to the questions on the form must be written in the space provided. Do not attach a separate page.
- Paragraph** - write a paragraph (200 -300 words) concerning your future plans working for the Lord and His Church.
- Letter of Reference** - You are required to submit one letter of reference. This reference should be from the applicant's pastor affirming church membership and recommendation for scholarship. The letter of reference form has been enclosed with this application. The letter of reference must be submitted with your application. This letter may be, but is not required to be sealed or confidential.
- Acceptance Letter/Proof of Enrollment** - You are required to include a copy of the acceptance letter you received from the educational institution you will be attending or proof of enrollment.
